# Itinerary

DAY  
1

*Arrival in Strasbourg*

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DAY  
2

*Strasbourg – Sélestat/surroundings*

| approx. 25-55 km

You leave Strasbourg on the cycle path along the Rhone-Rhine Canal, heading south.

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DAY  
3

*Sélestat/surroundings – Colmar*

| approx. 50-65 km

You cycle over the Rieddörfer and along the channel from Markolsheim which brings you to the artistic town of Colmar.

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DAY  
4

*Colmar – Mulhouse/surrounding*

| approx. 65 km

On beautiful laid out cycle paths you go via Neuf-Brisach to Ottmarsheim. It is worth visiting the basilica built in the 12th century. Continue along the cycle path along the Rhine Canal to the centre of Mulhouse.

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DAY  
5

*Mulhouse/surrounding – Guebwiller*

| approx. 35 km

Along cycle paths and small roads you pass the open air museum, the "Eco-museum of Alsace", until Ungersheim. Then continue on the route at the foot of the Vosges peaks until you reach Guebwiller.

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DAY  
6*Guebwiller – Riquewihr/surroundings*

| approx. 50 km

The villages of Eguisheim, Turckheim, Kaysersberg and Riquewihr are among the most beautiful and most famous villages of the wine route. Take your time and do some wine tasting!

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DAY  
7*Riquewihr/surroundings – Obernai/surroundings*

| approx. 50 km

A multitude of beautiful wine villages and well-known vineyards awaits you today.

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DAY  
8*Obernai/surroundings – Strasbourg*

| approx. 40 km, departure or extension

In Rosheim, the Alsatian Romanesque experience reaches a climax with the 12th century church of St. Peter and St. Paul. Then you follow the Canal de la Bruche to Strasbourg. Departure.

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# Tour character

You cycle mostly on bike paths, tarred agricultural roads and sometimes on side streets with less traffic. The stages in the vineyards are a little bit hilly.
