# Itinerary

DAY  
1

## *Individual arrival in Trogir, Trogir – Brač island*

approx. 25 km

**By boat: Trogir – Brač island. Cycling tour: round trip Brač island.**

You can embark the boat between 12 and 2 pm in Trogir. You then get to know your travel guide whilst having a drink. Once all guests are on board, the anchor is raised and the ship sails to Supetar on Brač island. This is where you will hop onto your bike and cycle to Pucisca where your captain awaits.

DAY  
2

## *Brač island – Korčula island,*

approx. 35 km

**By boat: Brač island – Pelješac peninsula, Pelješac peninsula – Korčula island**

In the morning, the boat takes you to the Pelješac peninsula, more specifically to a small village called Lovište. In this concealed bay, you leave the boat and cycle via Viganj and Kučište to Orebić. This last town is the *main city* on the peninsula and lies at the foot of Sveti Iliha mountain (961 metres). The boat awaits you there and takes you over to Korčula island. This afternoon's bike tour takes you to Račišće. From there, you cycle back to Korčula and then to Lumbarda where you will spend the night.

DAY  
3

## *Korčula island – Mljet island – Elafiti archipelago*

approx. 30 km

**By boat: Korčula island – Mljet island, Mljet island – Elafiti island of Šipan, Cycling tour: circular tour from Sobra**

The day starts with a cruise to Mljet island. The island is almost completely covered in forest and has a large national park with free-roaming mongoose. You cycle through vast forests via Prožura to Saplnara. After a break for lunch and swimming you cycle back to the boat, which will be heading for the Elafiti archipelago once you are on board.

DAY  
4*Elafiti archipelago – Dubrovnik,* | approx. 10 km**By boat:** Šipán island – Dubrovnik. **Cycling tour:** circular tour from Šipanska Luka

The archipelago consists of 13 islands and is largely uninhabited. Formerly it was a popular summer residence for the aristocracy. Today there are still many elegant villas here, some of which you will get to see on a short tour of Šipán island by bike. You continue to Dubrovnik by boat. You will arrive here at lunchtime and will have plenty of time to explore this famous UNESCO World Heritage Site.

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DAY  
5*Dubrovnik – Pelješac peninsula* | approx. 35 km**By boat:** Dubrovnik – Pelješac peninsula, Pelješac peninsula – Korčula island

In the morning you set sail for Prapratno on the Pelješac peninsula. You hop onto your bike and cycle to Ston and Mali Ston, two places connected by a 5.5 km long wall. This is where the biggest saline formations of the entire Mediterranean can be found, which have been here since before the birth of Christ. Via Dubrava and Žuljana you cycle to Trstenik, where your boat awaits you to take you to Kučište

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DAY  
6*Pelješac peninsula – Hvar island* | approx. 40 km**By boat:** Korčula Island – Hvar island. **Cycling tour:** circular tour via Vrboska and Jelsa

In the morning you are brought to Hvar island. In the town of Hvar you get back into the saddle to enjoy a tour through fields of lavender and vineyards to Stari Grad. The boat awaits you with a delicious lunch on board. With new energy you take off on the second part of today's bike tour. You cycle via Vrboska to Jelsa and back to Stari Grad. The oldest settlement on the island is a perfect place to enjoy the romantic atmosphere and beautiful colours as the sun sets into the sea.

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DAY  
7*Hvar island – Trogir* | approx. 20 km**By boat:** Hvar island – Šolta island, Maslinica – Trogir (by boat)

You go by boat from Stari Grad to Stomorska on Šolta island, one of the smaller Dalmatian islands. It is known for its very good olive oil, which is a great souvenir to take back home. Your last cycle tour on this trip comes to an end in Maslinica. After having lunch and perhaps a swim, you return to Trogir.

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## *Individual departure*

Your bike and barge holiday in Croatia ends after breakfast. Please disembark by 9am.

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# Tour character

The cycle tours require at least a basic level of fitness, which you should have acquired by occasional or daily cycling. The routes can take you up to an altitude of about 100 – 300 metres above sea level. You will cycle between 20 and 40km each day through hilly and mountainous terrain. You have plenty of time to complete each cycle ride.

Sometimes there will be steeper climbs, but of course it is okay to push your bike if you want to. The roads are mostly asphalted and there is little traffic outside of holiday-periods. It's your choice whether you want to cycle self-guided with maps and information material or if you want to do a guided cycle tour. Anyone under the age of 18 is required to wear a cycle helmet.

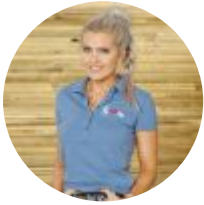
