Round the Dolomites

BY E-BIKE OR SPORTIVE.

The Dolomites are your constant companions during this round tour with the e-bike or trekking bike (for sporty cyclists), on the list of UNESCO world heritage due to their "unique monumental beauty".

Start point of this tour is Hochpustertal, demarcating the Dolomites towards the North. Then you continue along the Eisack- and Etsch Valleys, forming the west boarder, passing South Tyrol's capital Bozen/Bolzano and reaching Trento. On the southern part of the Dolomites you will cycle through Valsugana Valley to Feltre. The former Dolomites railway track will lead you into the direction of the Olympic town Cortina d'Ampezzo. Finally you will greet the famous Three Peaks before you return to the Pustertal valley.

Itinerary

DAY
1

Arrival to Hochpustertal (Niederdorf/Toblach)

Arrival to your starting hotel in valley "Hochpustertal" in the heart of the Dolomites.

DAY
2

Hochpustertal – Klausen | approx. 80-85 km

On the first part of today's route the Pustertal-cycling-path will show you the way. River Rienz accompanies you to Bruneck/Brunido, inviting you for a rest and a stroll through the city. Back in the saddle you pass the ruins of Mühlbacher Klause – the final point of the Pustertal. Shortly before Brixen/Bressanone you can visit the convent of Neustift or the fortress Franzensfeste. Brixen is worth to be visited as well. From afar convent Säben is welcoming you located high over the city of Klausen, where you will spend the night.

DAY
3

Klausen – Trento | approx. 90 km

From Klausen you cycle along river Eisack to Waidbruck, from where you will admire the view on castle Trostburg. The valley leads you to South Tyrol's capital city Bolzano. After a visit of Bozen's pedestrian and shopping area "Lauben" and the fruit market you will follow river Etsch and leave South Tyrol passing the "Salurner Klause" – border between the German speaking South Tyrol and the Italian speaking Trentino. Fruit trees and wine yards accompany your way to the former bishop's town Trento with its inviting historic town and castle Buonconsiglio.

DAY
4

Trento – Feltre | approx. 95 km (or 65 km + train ride)

You cycle past Lake Caldonazzo, inviting you for a longer stop. The first part after Caldanazzo is quite steep and can also be shortened by train (not included). Through the impressive Valsugana valley the way leads you to Feltre, a small city on the former "Via Claudia Augusta", an important Roman road from Aquileia to Augsburg.

DAY
5*Feltre – Pieve di Cadore* | approx. 85 km

Through an alley of broad-leaved forests you reach Belluno, small capital city of the homonymous province. Today you will pass picturesque village, inviting you for a rest every now and then. Towards north you look back to the mighty Dolomites, your companion during the first stages. You continue your way back north, passing Longarone. This town was rebuilt in a very short time after it was flooded by a tidal wave in 1963 which was caused by a rockfall into the former Vajont Dam reservoir. On the new cycling path you will get from Longarone to Pieve di Cadore, where you will spend the night.

DAY
6*Pieve di Cadore – Hochpustertal* | approx. 60-65 km

Pure nature is the motto of today's stage. The most important stop of the former Dolomites railway has been Cortina D'Ampezzo surrounded by some of the most famous Dolomites peaks - 1956 Winter Olympics have been celebrated there. Along the track of the former Dolomites railway you reach the border of the region Veneto and get back to South Tyrol. Enjoy the panoramic view on the famous "Three Peaks".

DAY
7*Departure or extension*

Tour character

This cycling tour has been designed especially for e-bikers. Most of the route follows cycling paths, sometimes quiet side roads. Though having the mighty Dolomites always in sight you cycle on beautiful paths at their feet down in the valleys. For sporty cyclists this route can be done also with a trekking bike.
