## *St. Moritz - Bolzano*

### ALONG THE INN AND ADIGE CYCLE PATH.

This tour is all about two rivers and three countries. You guessed it - there is a lot to experience. First-class cycle paths run along the Inn and Adige rivers, taking you from Switzerland through Austria and finally into Italy. Heavenly views of sublime mountains and glittering lakes, great culture and historic sites round off the offer. Will you come with us?

### *Details of the cycling tour from St. Moritz to Bolzano*

St. Moritz exudes a very special atmosphere. Use the first day to explore the chic town and then take a short round trip as the first stage. On day 3, the destination is Zernezz, which is considered the gateway to the Swiss National Park - which, by the way, is itself the oldest in the Alps.

On the following days you will pass some very characteristic mountain villages, e.g. the picturesque Lavin. In Scuol you will be spoiled for choice - cool off in the adventure pool or enjoy the culture at Tarasp Castle. The further south the route leads through Italy, the more Mediterranean the landscape becomes. The botanical garden in Merano is just as worth a visit as the "Ötzi" museum in Bolzano.

#### Highlights of the cycle tour with Eurobike

- **The sophisticated St. Moritz:** Immerse yourself for a few moments in the world of the rich and beautiful. Stroll through the extravagant boutiques, treat yourself to a cappuccino in one of the chic cafés and watch the noble clientele stroll by. Did you know? Snow polo is played on the town's frozen lake in winter.
- **The artists' village of Guarda** has been awarded the title "of national importance". The artistic paintings on the houses dates back to the 17th century. Guarda is also the home of the Schellenursli, a famous Swiss children's book character.

## *Arrival in St. Moritz*

If you arrive early enough, we recommend a first cycle tour to the lakes Silser See and St. Moritzer See even today.

## *Circular tour near St. Moritz approx. 40 km*

Enjoy the fascinating surroundings of St. Moritz. We recommend a bike tour around the lake towards Inn-Ursprung.

## *St. Moritz – Zernez*

| approx. 35 km

Cycle via Samedan (Old Tower), La Punt (early Gothic San-Andrea church with frescoes) and Zuoz (painted stained glass windows in the church San Luzi) to Zernez. The cycle path leads through the high-altitude valley of the Oberengadin region. Zernez is the gateway to the National Park (National Park house).

## *Zernez – Scuol*

| approx. 35 km

Initially you cycle to Lavin, which has kept the character of an old mountain village. The name of the picturesque village Guarda („Look“) comes from the brilliant view you can enjoy from there. Day 3 Finish is Scuol, with a water park «Bogn Engiadina» and Tarasp castle, the majestic landmark of the Engadin.

DAY  
5*Scuol – Burgeis/Mals* | approx. 60 km

From Scuol via Martina to the border. The first Austrian village Pfunds. From here transfer by bus to Nauders. There are just under 70 metres in altitude left up to the Reschen-pass. Descent towards lake Reschensee and onwards on side tracks to Mals (centre of village with many towers) or Burgeis at the foot of Marienburg castle.

DAY  
6*Burgeis/Mals – Merano* | approx. 65 km

For now you cycle to Glurns (totally preserved medieval city wall). Via the Montani-ruins through Schlanders and down to Merano. Castles and palaces (Juval palace owned by mountaineer Reinhold Messners) tower high above or directly on the route. While cycling enjoy the view onto the impressive Ortler massif and the Stilfserjoch. Since 2004 the Vinschgaubahn between Mals and Merano is back in operation and can be used at any time to shorten a bit of the way.

DAY  
7*Merano – Auer* | approx. 55 km

Via Lana (Schnatterpeck-altar) and through countless orchards and vineyards in the area of the South Tyrolean wine route past many defensive castles, palaces and ruins such as Hocheppan (significant frescoes) as well as at the 'cathedral in the countryside' (Dom auf dem Lande) in St. Pauls all the way to lake Caldaro. You usually stay in the cosy wine town Auer.

8*Auer – Bolzano* | approx. 35 km

From the enchanting wine village, you cycle on flat terrain through the Adige valley or (more scenic however with bigger ascent) via the Montiggler lakes, past Sigmundskron, to Bolzano (arbour alleys, 'Ötzi' - museum).

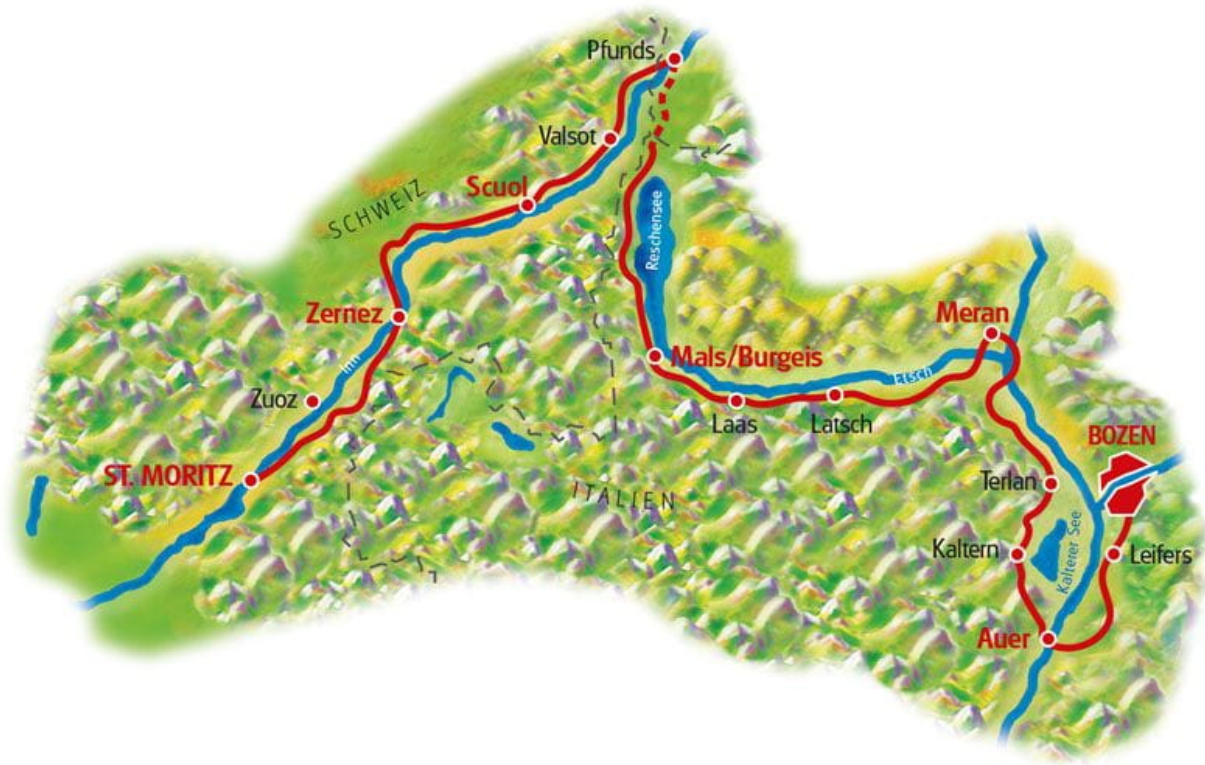

# Tour character

You cycle on marvellously well-maintained cycle paths mainly along the rivers Inn and Adige. The total route descends from start to finish over nearly 1200 metres in altitude. Nevertheless, small ascents will be part of the route too. You mainly cycle on bike paths (especially in Switzerland on dirt or gravel surfaces) or on asphalted rural tracks. For very short sections however you may have to cycle on roads with moderate traffic when it is unavoidable
